The Godhead Three

Paul told those in Athens that their own poets have said, “For we are also His offspring.” (Acts 17 : 28) We are the offspring of God, not the other way around. He created us, We did not create Him.

- * Who is the supreme Divinity, the Godhead
 - The Father, The Son, The Holy Spirit
- * How do we relate this—how are Three One?
 - Think of water—In a Solid, Liquid, or Gas—H²O is H²O
 - All three (Father, Son, Holy Spirit) are God—always
- * Draw your own diagram to understand how Three are One.
- * How do we relate this—what roles does Each have?
 - The Architect, Contractor, Interior Decorator
- * God the Father the Architect
 - It was Father's plan to predestine us for salvation.
- * God the Son the Contractor
 - It was the Son who all things were made. The Son came to do the will of the Father.
- * God the Holy Spirit the Interior Decorator
 - It was the Holy Spirit who came after the Son to convict the world, to teach, and to bring into remembrance all things the Son established.
