# The Case for Christ

## Prophecy

### Prophecy

‘nebuah’ (h) – a prediction

‘propheteia’ (g) – a prediction

‘prophetes’ (g) – a foreteller

‘prophetikos’ (g) - pertaining to a foreteller

A foretelling; prediction; a declaration of something to come. The prophecies recorded in Scripture, when fulfilled, afford the most convincing evidence of the divine origin of the Scriptures, as those who prophesied could not have foreknown the events predicted without Divine instruction.

# The Case for Christ

## Prophecy

### II Peter 1 : 19 – 21

The Word is “...prophetic...”

from a prophet

No prophecy is by “...private interpretation...”

‘idios’ - pertaining to self, that is, one's own; by implication private or separate

‘epilysis’ - explanation, that is, application

No prophecy has been explained by someone of their own intellect / knowledge.

No prophecy came by “...the will of man...”

‘thelema’ - a determination, that is, (actively) choice

# The Case for Christ Prophecy

## The death of the Christ

Who He would be

Revelation 5 : 1 – 7

The Sacrificial Lamb

How do you sacrifice a lamb?

Exodus 12 : 5, 46

Without blemish and none of its bones shall be broken

Why sacrifice a lamb?

Exodus 12 : 12 – 13

God will pass over them and not execute judgment

# The Case for Christ Prophecy

## The death of Jesus

Who He would be

John 1 : 29

Jesus is the Lamb of God

How do you sacrifice a lamb?

Luke 23 : 13 – 25

Jesus was without blemish

John 19 : 31 – 37

None of Jesus' bones were broken

“They shall look on Him whom they pierced.” Zachariah 12 : 10

Why sacrifice a lamb?

II Corinthians 5 : 18 – 19

God has reconciled us by Jesus – God passes us by for judgment

# The Case for Christ Prophecy

## The death of the Christ

How His death would occur

Psalm 41 : 7 – 9

Betrayed by a friend

Isaiah 53 : 7 – 8

He would be tried and not defend Himself

Isaiah 50 : 5 – 6

He would be beaten

Isaiah 53 : 12

He will be “numbered with the transgressors”

# The Case for Christ

## Prophecy

### The death of Jesus

#### How His death would occur

Matthew 26 : 47 – 56

Jesus was betrayed by Judas – a friend

Matthew 27 : 11 – 14

Jesus answered not one word for a defense

Matthew 26 : 67 – 68; 27 : 27 – 31

Jesus was beaten, spat upon, struck and mocked

Matthew 27 : 33 – 38

Jesus was crucified with two robbers, one on the right and another on the left.

“They divided My garments among them, and for My clothing they cast lots.” Psalm 22 : 18

# The Case for Christ Prophecy

## The burial of the Christ

Isaiah 53 : 9

His grave will be with the wicked  
He would be buried with the rich

## The burial of Jesus

Mark 15 : 42 – 47

Jesus died as a “wicked”  
Jesus was buried in Joseph’s Tomb, a prominent  
council member.

# The Case for Christ

## Prophecy

### The resurrection of the Christ

Psalm 16 : 9 – 11

He would see no corruption

He would rise from the dead

### The resurrection of Jesus

Matthew 28 : 1 – 8

Jesus rose from the dead

Acts 2 : 31

Jesus saw no corruption

# The Case for Christ Prophecy

## The ascension and glorification of the Christ

Psalm 68 : 18 – 19

The Christ will ascend on high

Psalm 110 : 1

The Christ will sit at the right hand of God

## The ascension and glorification of Jesus

Acts 1 : 9

Jesus ascended into Heaven

Hebrews 1 : 13

Jesus is sitting now at the right hand of God

“Hereafter the Son of Man will sit on the right hand of the power of God.” Luke 22 : 69

# The Case for Christ

## Prophecy

### The Finality of the Christ

Who He would be – Sacrificial Lamb

No bones will be broken

Without Blemish

God will pass over

He would be betrayed by a friend

Tried but not defend

He would be beaten

He would be numbered with transgressors

He would be buried with the rich

He would see no corruption

He would be resurrected

He would ascend on high and receive glorification from God

### The Finality of Jesus

Jesus was the Lamb of God

No bones were broken

No fault was found in Him

God will pass us

He was betrayed by Judas

He was tried but did not defend

He was beaten

He was numbered with robbers

He was buried in Joseph's tomb

He saw no corruption

He was resurrected

He ascended on high and received glorification from God

# The Case for Christ Prophecy

Jesus

Was Born according to Prophecy

Lived according to Prophecy

Died according to Prophecy

Was Buried according to Prophecy

Was Raised according to Prophecy

Was Ascended and Glorified according to Prophecy

Therefore Jesus must be the Christ
