'gumneteuo' – to strip

'gumnos' - nude

Genesis 2:25

"And they were both naked...and were not ashamed."

How is it that they were naked and not ashamed? What happened to make nakedness wrong?

Genesis 3:5-7

Knowing Good and Evil

Desiring to make wise

Eyes were opened

Knew they were naked

Genesis 3:5-7
What were their eyes opened to?
Lust, Shame, Desire, Uncleanness, Lasciviousness, etc.

What did this new found revelation get them?

SIN

"...they sewed fig leaves together and made themselves coverings."

KJV, ASV – aprons ESV - loincloths

'chagor' - a belt (for the waist); a girdle; girdle, belt, girdle, loin-covering, belt, loin-cloth, armor

They made for themselves a loin-cloth covering for their waste line.

Genesis 3:8-11

Where are you?

They were hidden. – Why?

I was afraid

Why? – I was naked

What did God do for their nakedness?

Genesis 3:21

"...the LORD God made tunics of skin, and clothed them."

'kethoneth' - to cover; a tunic; tunic, under-garment, a long shirt-like garment usually of linen 'labash' - properly wrap around, that is, (by implication) to put on a garment or clothe (oneself, or another)

Exodus 28:1-8,42

Moses is told to make garments:

Breastplate, an ephod, a robe, a skillfully woven tunic, a turban, and a sash.

All pieces to cover the top of their body.

Linen trousers; they shall reach from the waist to the thighs Clothing to cover their bottom of their body.

Why was Moses told to make these garments?

"...to cover their nakedness..."

Application so far:

Uncovering of our chest is wrong – Genesis 3

Going topless – Men and Women

Clothing that when moving would expose the chest, mid-drift, small of the back, etc.

Tank tops, bikinis, one-piece swim suits

Uncovering of our lower bodies is wrong – Exodus 28

Clothing that when moving would expose our thigh, our waste – any portion of our body between our knees and our hips.

Low ride jeans, "short-shorts", bathing suit bottoms

Where does this apply?

In our home – even among family member

Genesis 9: 19 - 26

Our children should not see the "nakedness" of parents, even by accident.

Leviticus 18:6 – 18

God tells the Israelites not to uncover nakedness of family Instructions were given to both the parents and the children

In worship

Exodus 20: 26; 28

In everyday life

Genesis 3

It was only Adam and Eve – yet God clothed them
