Response

Mark 11 : 14

“In response Jesus said to it...”

‘apokrinomai’ - to conclude for oneself, that is, (by implication) to respond; to give an answer to a question proposed, to answer

An answer or reply; particularly, an oracular answer.

Reply to an objection in a formal disputation.

Great Responses

I Samuel 3 : 1 – 10

“Speak, for Your servant hears.” (NASV – listening)

‘shama’ - to hear intelligently (often with implication of attention, obedience, etc.); to hear, listen to, obey

Revelation 2 : 7 (2 : 11, 17, 29; 3 : 6, 13, 22)

“He who has ears, let him hear what the Spirit says...”

The Result:

I Samuel 3 : 19

“So Samuel grew, and the Lord was with him...”

Great Responses

Isaiah 6 : 1 – 8

“Here I am, send me.”

‘shalach’ - to send away, for, or out (in a great variety of applications)

John 4 : 34 – 35

“...the fields, for they are already white for harvest!”

But, who will go?

Matthew 28 : 19

“Go...make disciples...baptizing...”

But who will go?

Great Responses

Nehemiah 7 : 73 – 8 : 6

“Amen, Amen!”

‘amen’ - sure; verily, truly, amen, so be it

II Kings 22 : 3 – 11

“...I have found the Book of the Law...and he read it...Shaphan read it before the king...”

“I was glad when they said to me, “Let us go into the house of the Lord.”” Psalm 122 : 1

Matthew 6 : 10

“...Your will be done...”

Great Responses

Acts 4 : 12 – 19

“Whether it is right...to listen to you more than to God, you judge.”

‘dikaios’ - equitable (in character or act); righteous, observing divine laws

Daniel 3 : 14 – 18

“...we have no need to answer you...we do not serve your gods, nor...worship the gold image...”

Daniel 6 : 6 – 10

“Now when Daniel knew that the writing was signed, he went home...with his windows open...he knelt...three times...and prayed...”

Not So Great of a Response

Matthew 26 : 69 – 74

“...I do not know...I do not know...I do not know the Man!”

Titus 1 : 16

“...in works they deny Him...”

Jude 4

“...ungodly men, who...deny the only Lord God and our Lord Jesus Christ.”

‘arneomai’ - to contradict, that is, disavow, reject, abnegate

“But whoever denies Me before men, him I will also deny before My Father...” Matthew 10 : 33

Not So Great of a Response

Acts 24 : 25; 26 : 28

“...Go away for now...You almost persuaded me...”

‘oligos’ - puny (in extent, degree, number, duration or value)

Romans 3 : 23

“...fall short...”

Hebrews 12 : 15

“...lest anyone fall short...”

‘hustereo’ -to be later, that is, (by implication) to be inferior; to be left behind in the race and so fail to reach the goal, to fall short of the end
