What did the servants say?

“We know you.”

What will Jesus say?

It's only important if I know you.

It's not who you know...It's who knows you.

What did Jesus say?

The kingdom of Heaven is like this:

In that day many will call Him, "Lord"

'kurios' - supreme in authority; he to whom a person
or thing belongs, lord or master

We belong to You, You are our Master.

In that day Jesus will say to them, "I do not know you"

'oida' (NASEC) - to have seen or perceived, hence to know
You do not belong to Me, I do not even know who
you are.

It's not who you know...It's who knows you.

Matthew 7 : 21 – 23

“Not everyone who says...Lord, Lord...”

‘kurios’ - supreme in authority; he to whom a person or thing belongs, lord or master

“...I never knew you...”

‘oudepote’ - not even at any time, that is, never at all

What is Jesus saying?

It's not important that you think you know Me.

What is Jesus' point?

It's only important if I know you.

It's not who you know...It's who knows you.

Matthew 7 : 21 – 23

“Many will say...in that day,
‘Lord, Lord...’”

These people, in that day, will claim to know Jesus.

Why do they think they know Him?

“...have we not cast out demons...done many wonders in
Your name?”

They make this claim for what “they” have been doing.

How does one know Jesus?

I John 2 : 3

“...we keep His commandments.”

It's not who you know...It's who knows you.

How is it that we say we do His will, yet He does not know us?

I John 2 : 4

“...is a liar...”

John 8 : 42 – 45

“...you do not believe Me.”

Luke 6 : 46

“But why do you call Me 'Lord, Lord,' and not do the things which I say?”

It's not who you know...It's who knows you.

Do you know Jesus?

Does He know you?

John 10 : 14

“I am the good shepherd; and I know My sheep...”

II Timothy 2 : 19

“The Lord knows those who are His,”

It's not who you know...It's who knows you.

How does He know us?

Matthew 10 : 32 – 33

We confess Him; He will confess us.

Matthew 25 : 31 – 46 (40, 45-46)

To take care of those who are His, is for Him to know you.

Matthew 7 : 21

We do the will of His Father, is for Him to know you.
