Marvelous Thing (wrought wonders)

Psalms 78: 12

'pele' - a miracle

Marvelous Work

Isaiah 29 : 14

"Therefore, behold, I will proceed to do a marvelous work among this people, even a marvelous work and a wonder: for the wisdom of their wise men shall perish, and the understanding of their prudent men shall be hid."

> 'pala' - properly perhaps to separate, that is, distinguish (literally or figuratively); to be marvelous, be wonderful, be surpassing, be extraordinary, separate by distinguishing action

What is a miracle?

Wonders

Psalms 105 : 5

'mopheth' - in the sense of conspicuousness; wonder, sign, miracle, portent

Miracle (Signs)

John 4:54

Acts 4:16

'semion' - an indication, especially ceremonially or supernaturally; a sign, prodigy, portent, i.e. an unusual occurrence, transcending the common course of nature

The Biblical definition:

An event or effect contrary to the established constitution and course of things, or a deviation from the known laws of nature; a supernatural event.

God's first miracle

Genesis 1: 1 – 2

God out of nothing, outside of nature, created, made come into existence, that which was not there before.

God in His creation, created the known laws of nature.

Sun / Moon = 24 hr. period = 1 day

Earth revolves around the sun = 365 days = 1 year
