 - By the testimony of two is true
 - With the mouth confession is made.
- * I bear witness of Myself
 - I—The word by which a speaker or writer denotes himself
 - Am—to be, to exist
- * I Am—The bread of life
 - Man does not live by bread alone—but by the Word of God
 - Jesus is that Word, that Bread from Heaven
- * I Am—The light of the word
 - Without Light, the Word of God, man is in Darkness
 - Jesus is that Word, the Light to our path
- * How is Jesus both the Bread of Life and the Light of the World?
 - Jesus is the Word, which became flesh
- * Can you confess Jesus as the Christ?
