For Tomorrow We Die

Life is precious, but it also extremely fragile. One minute it is here, and the next, it is gone. James put it this way, our life, he says, is “like a vapor.”

There are two questions which man desires to know the answer to. The first, “What happens after I die?” Through scripture we can get a fairly good idea on what happens.

However, it is the second question, which has no man can answer. “When will I die?” Only God Himself, knows this answer. But what if you knew you were going to die tomorrow. What would you do?

Would you call your family? Would you check your insurance policies? What would you do to *set your house in order*?

There is a philosophy which states that one should live their life as if there is no tomorrow. On one hand, this philosophy teaches that it does not matter how you live your life, because one day you die.

However, on the other hand, and the way we need to consider it the philosophy can teach that one day we will die, and we need to prepare every day as if it is our last. If this is truly your last day, are you prepared for no tomorrow?
