2. What has Christ made them? What problem then were they having?

5 : 1, 7—9

3. What were some teaching the Gentiles, and why?

6 : 12—13

Bonus** What main problem does Paul address to the Church at Galatia? Although we do not have this same problem some 2,000 years later, what problems do we have that put us in the same light as they? Remember—we have this book for a reason.

4. What does James call us to be? What does it mean?

James 1 : 22—25

5. Can faith save you, if so how? (careful this is somewhat of a trick question)

2 : 14, 17—18, 26
