Old Law – Holy

New Law – Holy

John 4: 23 - 24

"...true worshipers...must worship in spirit and truth."

'proskuneo' - to fawn or crouch to, that is, (literally or figuratively) prostrate oneself in homage (do reverence to, adore)

Today – Rock Concert, a Carnival, a Social Event "Worship God the way YOU choose"

God is not our "papa" our "friend"

He is our Creator. Our God.

He is to be revered, to be awed, to be respected, to be glorified.

Are you afraid of your friends?

How about God? (Proverbs 15 : 16; 16 : 8)

Adam/Eve – at the sound of His voice.
